### **Learning in a relaxed and green environment**

Our school grounds cover 20 ha of woodland, surrounding our Nursery, Primary and Secondary school buildings.

### **Multilingual education in a multicultural environment**

Children of different native languages and nationalities are educated from age 3 to the end of Secondary education. From Primary school entry, pupils are taught a second language and many leave school being fluent in four languages. Our teachers are native speakers provided by the EU member states.

### **A wide range of Science and Humanities subjects**

Our approach to learning focuses on the practical. Primary and Secondary pupils work on projects combining Art, Music, ICT, Languages and the Sciences.

### **An extensive ICT and multimedia infrastructure**

ICT permeates all curriculum delivery. We operate an internal platform of e-learning resources and

from an early age pupils use the latest technologies. The school is the Distance Learning Centre for the European School system, equipped with the latest video-conferencing facilities and e-learning technologies.

### **Study rooms and library under the supervision of pedagogical advisors**

During lesson-free periods, Secondary pupils can work in a comprehensive library. A qualified librarian is able to assist with their research. The library in the Primary school is a well-stocked multi-lingual learning resource.

### **Cultural activities and excursions**

School trips and a wide range of activities in the areas of Sport, Drama, Music, Dance, Computing, etc are organised both by the school and by the Parents Association.

### **Indoor swimming pool**

A full-size heated pool is used for lessons and recreation. Other Sports take place on the large playing areas that house three gymnasiums, tennis courts, football & basketball fields.

### **Canteen under the supervision of a dietician**

The school has an excellent canteen where hot and cold lunches are served daily. Parents are able to join pupils and teachers at lunchtime.

### **Internal medical service**

The school nurse is at all times available for pupils and staff at the school's medical rooms.

### **An external boarding facility and organised bus transport:**

Opportunities exist for pupils to lodge with host families or in an educational boarding house. Many pupils travel daily by bus from distances of over 60km.

### **A school-leaving certificate (European Baccalaureate)**

The diploma pupils receive on successful graduation is recognised in all universities of the European Union and in many universities overseas.
