



De medical service of the European School MOL (SMS)

Who are we?

The medical team has one school doctor, Dr. Andreas Verbeke and one school nurse, Mrs Yoke Moortgat

Where and when can we be reached?

You can find us in the building of the primary school. The school nurse is present during school hours; the school doctor on Thursday afternoon. The phone number of the medical service is 014/56 31 40

What do we do?

- **Medical consultations**

- General medical examinations: all new students, all small children, all pupils of year 1 and year 5 year of the primary school and all students of year 3 and year 5 of the secondary school.
- Selective examinations for special problems
- Individual examinations on the demand of the pupil, the parents or the school

- **Supervision vaccinations**

We do not administer vaccinations at our school. We only do the follow-up of the administered or necessary vaccinations. We refer you to your GP or paediatrician to administer the vaccinations.

To facilitate this process it is very important to give in the exact dates of previous vaccinations.

- **Advice**

You can contact us for all kinds of problems: hygiene, health, teeth, safety etc. We will always try to find a solution; if necessary we will contact other services.

All contact with the medical team is confidential

- **Multi-disciplinary consultation**

Because the medical service is mainly advisory, it is very important that there is a continuous follow-up of your child. For that reason we ask you to report any problems and we also ask permission to ask for your child's file from his former school. The data is stored in a personal electronic file.

- **School insurance**

The school is covered by insurance in case of an accident at school (or on the way to/ from the school). The forms needed to advise of an accident are available at the medical service; the school nurse does the follow-up. When the parents are unable to come immediately when their child has a severe accident the school nurse will accompany the child to the hospital, if necessary.

- **Sick children**

In case of an acute illness and the parents are unable to come and get their child, a student can stay at the medical service. However, children can not be sent sick to the school to stay a whole day at the medical service.

- **Contagious diseases**

In case of a contagious disease we will immediately notify all parents, therefore we also ask you to report to the school in case where your child has / is suspected of a contagious disease.

Where and when can we be reached?

- **Fill in forms**

When you enrol your child and every time your child has a medical examination, you will receive a number of forms. Please fill them in as completely as possible.

- **Health**

Should anything happen that can influence your child's behaviour / health (accident, decease etc.); please inform the medical service, so we can provide the best possible care for your child.

If your child should get lice or nits, please inform us, so we can alert the other parents (without revealing the name of your child)

- **Contact the medical service**
